

Sharing to the Professional Network

On ObjectiveEd you can share the custom goals and braille sheets you have made with your colleagues on the Professional Network. This creates a unique way for teachers to share the goals they have made with each other so that other teachers can try it with their students.


You can share

- 1). Goals
- 2). Braille Sheets

An example of a goal you might share,


You may have created a goal for learning contractions, and within that goal you may have made 5 or 6 skills that you designed to help a student learn contractions. You can share this goal to a group that you are a part of on the Professional Network so that other members of that group who have students learning contractions can import that goal to use with their student.

- 1). From your teacher dashboard, navigate to the “Databanks Page”





2). If you want to share a goal or a braille sheet. Select the “Share to network” button (Arrow icon) next to the goal/braille sheet you wish to share.
